The Canvass of the February 10th SILO election was held. Three (3) additional votes were counted. 2 Yes and 1 No with the following results:

Upon the public measure "Shall the following public measure be adopted? Local sales and services for school infrastructure projects shall be imposed in the County of Plymouth at the rate of one percent. The tax will begin on July 1, 2004. The tax will be in effect for a period of ten years until June 30, 2014. The money received from the tax shall be spent for school infrastructure or property tax relief as defined by Iowa Code Section 422E.1 and 422E.2(3A)(b).

"School infrastructure" is defined by law to include purchasing, building, furnishing, reconstruction, repairing, demolishing, expanding, improving or remodeling of a schoolhouse or schoolhouses and additions thereto, gymnasium, stadium, field house or school bus garage, and procuring a site or sites therefor or purchasing land to add to a site already owned, or procuring and improving a site for an athletic field, opening roads to schoolhouses or buildings, the purchase, lease or lease-purchase of buildings or equipment (including transportation and recreation equipment) as authorized by law, procuring or acquiring libraries, expenditures for energy conservation measures, the rental of facilities under Chapter 28E, or improving a site already owned for an athletic field, the payment or retirement of outstanding bonds previously issued for school infrastructure purposes or the payment or retirement of bonds issued under Iowa Code Section 422E.4 or for any one or more of such purposes, or for any purpose or purposes authorized by law."

There were two thousand one hundred seventy-four (2,174) votes cast as follows:

FOR the question there were one thousand three hundred five (1,305) votes cast.

AGAINST the question there were eight hundred sixty-nine (869) votes cast.

We therefore declare the public measure A-SILO to be adopted.

Motion by Vander Hamm, seconded by Sitzmann, to approve the SILO election results.

Motion carried.

The ordinance #021704 was approved concerning the SILO election beginning July 1, 2004 and running through June 30, 2014.

Motion by Vander Hamm, seconded by Greene, to approve an application for construction on Co. road ROW for Frontier Communications in Sec. 29/30, America Township and along C-38 100' East of Floyd River Bridge, then West approximately 1200'.

Motion carried.

Motion by Sitzmann, seconded by Vander Hamm, to approve an application for construction on Co. road ROW for Quest Communications in Sec. 28, Hungerford Township.

Motion carried.

Motion by Sitzmann, seconded by Greene, to approve the payment for LEC/JAIL claims with a change from \$33,826.70 for Tessiers to \$31,826.70.
