The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in the Boardroom on December 28, 2010 at 9:30 a.m. C. Gordon Greene was absent. All other members were present and all votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Loutsch, to approve the agenda for December 28, 2010. Motion Carried.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Loutsch, to approve the December 21, 2010 minutes. Motion Carried.

The Canvass of the Special Election to fill the vacancy for Kingsley Mayor held on December 21, 2010 was presented as follows:

For the office of Kingsley Mayor there were one hundred sixty-nine (169) votes cast as follows: Rick Bohle received one hundred twenty-five (125) votes; John Hackett received thirty-five (35) votes; scattering received nine (9) votes. We therefore declare Rick Bohle duly elected for the office of Kingsley Mayor for the residue of the term, ending on the 31st of December, 2011.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Anderson, to approve the Canvass as presented and approve the cost of said election. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Loutsch, to approve the change order quotation for 3 lights on the east side of the Courthouse Annex for \$1,660. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Kass, to approve a minor subdivision, Dirksen Ag, in Sec. 12 of America Township. Motion Carried.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Loutsch, to approve a minor subdivision, Dirksen Farms, in Sec. 6 of Marion Township. Motion Carried.

Motion by Loutsch, seconded by Anderson, to adjust the fence payment schedule to corner brace installation for irregular right of way to \$100, woven fence out at \$7.00, woven fence in at \$20.00, barb wire out at \$5.50 and barb wire in \$15.00. Motion Carried.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Anderson, approve the purchase of a Tier 3 Caterpillar 140M Motor grader for \$243,250 in FY 10-11 with local secondary road budget dollars and a Tier 3 Caterpillar 140M Motor grader purchase for \$243,250 in FY 10-11 with financing until September of 2011. Motion Carried.
