The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in the Boardroom on June 14, 2016, 2016 at 9:30 a.m. All members were present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated. Board Chairman Henrich called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Anderson, to approve the June 14, 2016 agenda. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Kass, to approve the minutes of the June 7, 2016 meeting. Motion Carried.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Meis, to approve payroll issued on 6/15/16. Motion Carried.

Canvass of the June 7, 2016 Primary Election was held with the following results:

For the office of County Supervisor District 2 – there was no Democratic candidate.

For the office of County Supervisor District 2 – Republican
Mark R. Loutsch received one thousand five hundred and seventy-six (1,576) votes.
Scattering received eleven (11) votes.
We therefore declare Mark R. Loutsch to be duly nominated as the Republican candidate.

For the office of County Supervisor District 5 – there was no Democratic candidate.

For the office of County Supervisor District 5 – Republican
Gary Horton received one thousand one hundred and thirty-five (1,135) votes.
Dan Smith received seven hundred and twenty-six (726) votes.
Scattering received one (1) vote.
We therefore declare Gary Horton to be duly nominated as the Republican candidate.

For the office of County Auditor – there was no Democratic candidate.

For the office of County Auditor – Republican
Stacey Feldman received one thousand six hundred and nineteen (1,619) votes.
Scattering received four (4) votes.
We therefore declare Stacey Feldman to be duly nominated as the Republican candidate.

For the office of County Sheriff – there was no Democratic candidate.

For the office of County Sheriff – Republican
Mike Van Otterloo received one thousand seven hundred and thirty-one (1,731) votes.
Scattering received eighteen (18) votes.
We therefore declare Mike Van Otterloo to be duly nominated as the Republican candidate.

Motion by Meis, seconded by Loutsch, to approve the canvass the 2016 Republican and Democrat Primary Elections. Motion Carried.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Meis, to suspend delinquent taxes from March 2016 for \$493.00 Jim Hofman for Military deployment. Motion Carried.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Meis, to approve the tile crossing permit for Section 8/17 of Marion Township on 180th St. Motion Carried.

Motion by Meis, seconded by Anderson, to approve a contract on Midwest Contracting for project FM-CO75(144). Motion Carried.

Motion by Meis, seconded by Anderson, to approve a permit for Frontier Communication in Grant Township in Sec 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 15, 16 and Elgin Township in Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 18. Motion Carried.

The Board reviewed paving estimates for approximately 500 feet by the intersection of C38/Lake Ave. Tom Rohe will be talking to the land owner about the project and issues with the drainage on the property.

The Board of Supervisors adjourned the meeting at 10:58 am.
