The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on July 11, 2001 with all members present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated.

Minutes of the June 27, 2001 meeting were read and approved.

The Board set a work day on July 17<sup>th</sup> for redistricting at 9:00 A.M. The Board also set August 8<sup>th</sup> as no-meeting day due to 5 Wednesdays that month.

Motion by Kestner, seconded by Vander Hamm, to approve the liquor permit for the Golden Pheasant. Motion carried.

The Sheriff's office quarterly report was presented.

Motion by Sitzmann, seconded by Spies, to approve the zoning boards recommendation of a change from ag conservation to ag rural residential for Bernard Junck on 2.73 acres in Section 18 of Lincoln Township. Motion carried.
