The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on April 10, 2002 with all members present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated.

Minutes of the April 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> meetings were read and approved.

Motion by Philips, seconded by Kestner, to authorize the Chairman to sign a contract amendment for \$8,652.00 with the Department of Public Health for a federal grant with no local match.

Motion by Sitzmann, seconded by Spies, to sign a voucher for federal dollars of \$1,269.08 for bioterrorism expenditures for the Health Nurse. Motion carried.

Motion by Spies, seconded by Philips, to approve the zoning boards recommendation of a change from ag conservation to ag rural residential for Perry and Diane Pinkerton on 2.81 acres in section 4 of Perry township. Motion carried.

Motion by Kestner, seconded by Sitzmann, to approve the zoning boards recommendation of a change from ag conservation to ag rural residential for Clyde Schuttpelz on 2.48 acres in section 13 of Henry township. Motion carried.

Motion by Spies, seconded by Kestner, to approve the zoning boards recommendation of a change from ag conservation to ag rural residential for Deloris C Klohs on 4.92 acres in section 20 of Remsen township. Motion carried.

Motion by Sitzmann, seconded by Philips, to approve the final plat of Lohry Addition in section 22 of Perry township and approve a change from ag conservation to rural residential on 13.68 acres. Motion carried.

Motion by Philips, seconded by Spies, to approve the zoning boards recommendation of a change from ag conservation to ag rural residential for Robert Varenhorst on 6.34 acres in section 2 of Preston township. Motion carried.

Motion by Kestner, seconded by Sitzmann, to approve the final plat of Don Crawford Addition on 4.06 acres in section 32 of Washington township and rezone the property from ag conservation to rural residential. Motion carried.

Motion by Sitzmann, seconded by Spies, to approve a minor subdivision in section 23 of Perry township on 31.85 acres and rezone the property from ag conservation to rural residential. Motion carried.

Motion by Spies, seconded by Sitzmann, to establish the fee for a minor subdivision at \$300.00 effective immediately. Motion carried.

Motion by Philips, seconded by Kestner, to approve an application for construction on county road right of way for Gerald Meyer in section 24 of Meadow township. Motion carried.

Motion by Spies, seconded by Sitzmann, to approve an application with the IDOT for project #BROS-CO75(86)—8J-75 bridge replacement in section 7 and 8 of Lincoln township. Motion carried.

Motion by Sitzmann, seconded by Philips, to adopt the secondary road budget for 2002-2003 and the 5-year construction program as presented. Motion carried.

The Board approved the Recorders quarterly report.

Motion by Philips, seconded by Kestner, to adopt the Plymouth County Courthouse Security Plan pending the change of the wording on page 9.
