The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on August 7, 2002 with all members present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated.

Minutes of the July 31, 2002 meeting were read and approved.

Motion by Sitzmann, seconded by Kestner, to sign a payment schedule policy for the LEC/jail construction project.
Signed copies of policy will be sent to all contractors. Motion carried.

Sheriff, Mike Van Otterloo, is recommending not entering into a 10 year, 10 bed contract with the U.S. Marshals office.

Motion by Kestner, seconded by Philips, to sign the contract for the state grant for public health nursing and home maker health. Motion carried.

Motion by Kestner, seconded by Philips, to approve the \$19,432.00 medication management request this year and review the request on a yearly basis. Jim DeMuth said his office will monitor the program and provide reports. Motion carried.

Motion by Philips, seconded by Sitzmann, to sign *Resolution 080702*
To abandon the east-west alley in Block 2 of James and the county road right of way at junction of Highway 75 and C-80 and transfer the respective parcels to adjacent property owners.

Motion by Philips, seconded by Kestner, to approve the hiring of Jim Bolton to fill secondary road position in Akron. Motion carried.

The DOT will hold a public hearing for the Highway 3, Highway 75 by-pass intersection west of Le Mars on August 27th at the Le Mars Public Library from 12:00 P.M. to 2:00 P.M.

Motion by Spies, seconded by Sitzmann, to sign contracts with Graves Construction for 2 projects let in Ames, BROS-CO75-(80)-8J-75 for \$175,957.00 and BROS-CO75-(83)-8J-75 for \$205,486.00. Motion carried.
