The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on February 27, 200. Present were Vander Hamm, Kestner, Sitzmann and Spies. Absent was Philips. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated.

Minutes of the February 20<sup>th</sup> and 26th meetings were read and approved.

Motion by Kestner, seconded by Sitzmann, to authorize the Chairman to sign a letter to the City of Le Mars asking for a 20' easement on the north side of Edward Drive S.E. Motion carried.

Motion by Spies, seconded by Kestner, to authorize the Chairman to sign contracts for the new jail with Chief Industries for \$241,925.00; Wiltgen Construction Company for \$2,713,617.00; Tessier's Inc for \$703,000.00; Great Plains Excell Fire Protection Inc for \$68,400.00; Langel's Electric Company for \$557,222.00 for a total of \$4,284,164.00. Motion carried.

Motion by Sitzmann, seconded by Spies, to adopt a time and place of hearing on a proposal to vacate and close a portion of secondary road in section 4 of Washington Township at 11:30 A.M. on March 13<sup>th</sup> in the supervisors room.
