The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on October 9, 2002 with all members present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated.

The Board took no action on the elderly tax credit asking for 2001.

Minutes of the October 2nd meeting were read and approved.

Motion by Sitzmann, seconded by Kestner, to waive the 14 day waiting period imposed by the DNR for Rick Langel's hog facility.

Grant administrator will be the County Auditor.

Motion by Philips, seconded by Sitzmann, to accept a \$4,000.00 change order from PCS for Wiltgen Construction to replace Northern Computer card access system with Gatekeeper card access system. Motion carried.

Motion by Philips, seconded by Kestner, to approve an application for construction on county road right of way for Southern Sioux County Rural Water in sections 27 and 34 of Elgin Township. Motion carried.

Motion by Philips, seconded by Kestner, to approve the Chairman signing the September invoicing for the law enforcement center/jail. Motion carried.

Motion by Sitzmann, seconded by Kestner, to sign a contract with SRTS for \$24,915.00 for fiscal year 2003. Motion carried.

Motion by Kestner, seconded by Sitzmann, to proceed with the creation of a local option sales tax advisory committee to the Board of Supervisors. Ayes---Kestner and Sitzmann. Nays---Philips, Spies and Vander Hamm. Motion failed.

The Board adjourned at 2:20 P.M.
