The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on September 12, 2003 to canvass the results of the School Board election held on September 9, 2003. All members were present except Philips.

Motion by Vander Hamm, seconded by Greene, to approve the canvass as follows.

AKRON-WESTFIELD

For the office of Director District 1, there were seventy (70) votes cast as follows: Jeff Klemme received sixty-nine (69) votes. We therefore declare Jeff Klemme duly elected to the office of Director District 1 for the term of 3 years.

For the office of Director District 2, there were seventy (70) votes cast as follows: Randy Becker received sixty-two (62) votes. We therefore declare Randy Becker duly elected to the office of Director District 2 for the term of 3 years.

For the office of Director District 3 (unexpired term), there were seventy (70) votes cast as follows: Gordon Johnson received sixty-eight (68) votes. We therefore declare Gordon Johnson duly elected to the office of Director District 3 (unexpired term) for the term of 1 year.

HINTON-COMMUNITY

For the office of Director At Large, there were forty-eight (48) votes cast as follows: Steve Eddy received forty-seven (47) votes; Michelle K. Rodgers received forty-three (43) votes. We therefore declare Steve Eddy and Michelle K. Rodgers duly elected to the office of Director At Large for the term of 3 years.

KINGSLEY-PIERSON

For the office of Director District 1, there were thirty-four (34) votes cast as follows: Julie Hlas received thirty-two (32) votes. We therefore declare Julie Hlas duly elected to the office of Director District 1 for a term of 3 years.

LEMARS COMMUNITY

For the office Director District 1, there were eighty-six (86) votes cast as follows: Leon E. Scott received eighty-five (85) votes. We therefore declare Leon E. Scott duly elected to the office Director District 1 for the term of 3 years.

For the Director District 4, there were eighty-six (86) votes cast as follows: Charles Holz received eighty-four (84) votes. We therefore declare Leon E. Scott duly elected to the office of Director District 4 for a term of 3 years.

REMSEN-UNION

For the office of Director District 1, there were ninety-nine (99) votes cast as follows: Jill Utesch received sixty-one (61) votes; Mary J. Ahlers received thirty (30) votes. We therefore declare Jill Utesch duly elected to the office of Director District 1 for the term of 3 years.

For the office of Director District 5, there were ninety-nine (99) votes cast as follows: Mark Joseph Wurth received twelve (12) votes. We therefore declare Mark Joseph Wurth duly elected to the office of Director District 5 for a term of 3 years.

WESTERN IOWA TECH COMMUNITY COLLEGE

For the office of Western Iowa Tech. Director District 1 (unexpired term), there were two hundred eighty-eight (288) votes cast as follows: Norm Lang received two hundred one (201) votes. We therefore declare Norm Lang duly elected to the office of WIT Director, District 1 (unexpired term) for the term of 1 year.

For the office of Western Iowa Tech Director District 8, there were two hundred one (201) votes cast as follows: Russell C. Wray received thirty-two (32) votes. We therefore declare Russell C. Wray duly elected to the office of WIT Director District 8 for the term of 3 years. Motion carried.
