Motion by Anderson, seconded by Henrich, to declare as surplus property to be sold at county auction the following property: 1960 ONAN Diesel generator, Heil gas furnace and 2003 Ford Crown Victoria. Motion Carried.

The Board reviewed a draft of a keg registration ordinance.

Leesa McNeil addressed the Board concerning Courthouse space.
