Motion by Anderson, seconded by Kass, to approve the agenda for July 13, 2010. Motion Carried.

Motion by Loutsch, seconded by Anderson, to approve the minutes of the June 29, 2010 meeting. Motion Carried.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Anderson, to approve Resolution #071310-1 to authorize the Commissioner of Elections to place the question on a ballot to the Fredonia Township voters at the General Election on November 2, 2010 which reads as follows: Should the County Board of Supervisors fill the offices of Trustee and Clerk in Fredonia Township by appointment?
