The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in the Boardroom on April 12, 2011 at 9:30 a.m. All members were present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated.

Motion by Loutsch, seconded by Kass, to approve the April 12, 2011 agenda. Motion Carried.

Motion by Loutsch, seconded by Anderson, to approve the April 5, 2011 minutes. Motion Carried.

Motion by Guenther, seconded by Kass, to not construct the steps and rail on the Courthouse Annex for a \$4,295 deduction and to add a retaining wall and rail to the basement building for \$5,146. Motion Carried.

Mary Lucken and Blaine Donaldson provided the 2011-12 Local Option Sales Tax Advisory Board recommendations of grant awards for Board approval on April 19th.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Don Kass, to approve Majeres Addition, a minor subdivision in Section 15 of Fredonia Township. Motion Carried.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Anderson, to approve the Recorder's January – March 2011 quarterly report, as presented by Jolynn Goodchild, Plymouth County Recorder. Motion Carried.

Mike Porter of the Pride Group was present to discuss fire safety requirements that have been suggested at the RCF. There are possibly 10 windows to replace. There was also discussion of putting doors back into the RCF that were removed years ago, which would lock, in conjunction with a better monitoring camera system. Mike is asking the County and The Pride Group work together on plans and costs on these issues.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Loutsch, to approve a permit for Knology to replace fiber optic cable in Section 12/13 of Hungerford Township. Motion Carried.

Motion by Loutsch, seconded by Anderson, to approve a railroad crossing agreement to U.P. Railroad in Section 4 of America Township on 160th St. Motion Carried.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Guenther, to approve the Secondary Road budget and five year construction program for submittal to the DOT with the revision to add 1 mile of 150th St. to 2015 budget. Motion Carried.
