The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in the Boardroom on April 5, 2016 at 9:30 a.m. All members were present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated. Board Chairman Henrich called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Kass, to approve the April 5, 2016 agenda. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Meis, to approve the minutes of the March 22, 2016 meeting. There was no meeting on March 29th, 2016. Motion Carried.

Motion by Meis, seconded by Loutsch, to approve wages paid on 3-24-16 and 3-31-16 and claims paid on April 5, 2016. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Meis, to set 10 am on April 19th as the public hearing date and time for the loan indebtedness in FY 16-17. Motion Carried.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Loutsch, to set 10 am on April 26th as the public hearing date and time for the FY 15-16 Budget Amendment. Motion Carried.

Motion by Loutsch, seconded by Anderson, to open the public hearing at 10:15 am to incur noncurrent debt (internal advancement of funds) in the Plymouth County Ethanol Urban Renewal Area to fund a highway project. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Meis, to close the public hearing at 10:16 am. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Kass, to approve Resolution 040516-1 authorizing the internal advance of funds in the Plymouth County Ethanol Urban Renewal area for road project costs. Loutsch-aye; Meis-aye; Henrich-aye; Kass-aye; Anderson-aye. Motion Carried.

Courtney McCrellias of the Council Against Sexual Assault (CASA) was present to discuss awareness of sexual assault. April 2016 was declared by Chairman Jim Henrich as Sexual Assault Awareness month.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Anderson, to approve Resolution 040516-2 to abate delinquent mobile home taxes of \$2,729 and a total including tax, penalty and interest of \$7,766 as presented by Treasurer, Shelly Sitzmann. Loutsch-aye; Meis-aye; Henrich-aye; Kass-aye; Anderson-aye. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Meis, to approve to proceed with a bid process of an E911 fiber project from LEC to east tower site. Motion Carried.

Motion by Meis, seconded by Anderson, to approve 7 tile crossing permits: Sec 22/27 Johnson Twp on 200th St – Brown; Sec 30 Henry Twp/Sec 25 Union Twp on Quest Ave – Krieg; Sec 36 Union Twp/Sec 31 Henry Twp on Quest Ave – Mockler; Sec 30 Henry Twp/Sec 25 Union Twp on Quest Ave – Bottjen; Sec 34/35 Henry Twp on Sunset Ave – Thompson; Sec 4/9 Fredonia Twp on 110th St – Scheitler; Sec 3/4 Elkhorn Twp on Pioneer Ave – Plendl.
