The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in the Boardroom on February 14, 2017 at 9:30 a.m. All members were present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated. Chairman Don Kass called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Meis, to approve the February 14, 2017 agenda. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Horton, to approve the minutes of the February 7, 2017 meeting. Motion Carried.

Motion by Meis, seconded by Horton, to approve the payroll dated February 10<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup>, 2017. Motion Carried.

Motion by Loutsch, seconded by Horton, to canvass and approve the following results from the Kingsley Pierson Special Election that was held on February 7, 2017, as presented by Plymouth County Auditor and Commissioner of Elections Stacey Feldman.

“Shall the following PPEL public measure be adopted?”

FOR the question, there were one hundred fifteen (115) votes

AGAINST the question, there were forty-one (41) votes

We therefore declare the public measure to be adopted.

Motion by Loutsch, seconded by Meis, to approve a permit to Western Iowa Telephone Association in Section 29 and 32 of Lincoln Township on Lynx Ave. and 320<sup>th</sup> St. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Horton, to approve final plans for BROS-CO75(146). Motion Carried.

The Board of Supervisors adjourned the Board meeting at 10:29 pm.

Motion by Loutsch, seconded by Horton, for the Board of Supervisors to meet as the Plymouth County Drainage Board at 10:30 am to discuss a driveway easement in the Akron Drainage District #2. Motion Carried.

Motion by Meis, seconded by Anderson, to approve a permit for a driveway easement for the City of Akron and Sixplex Care Center that is in the Akron Drainage Dist. #2 for the driveway to be used by the City of Akron/Sixplex Care Center and the future investors when it is sold. Motion Carried.

The Board discussed concerns of the old Iowa DOT property which has been sold to be the property for a new Casey's Convenience Store. Plans propose that it partially sits in the Akron Drainage Dist. #2 drainage easement and their need to cross the drainage ditch for access to the property from Plymouth Drive. The Board asked to see alternative plans before making a decision as to whether they will be able to grant an easement and permit the access over the drainage ditch.

Motion by Loutsch, seconded by Horton, to adjourn the Plymouth County Drainage Board at 11:08 am.
