Motion by Anderson, seconded by Meis, to approve the July 11, 2017 agenda. Motion Carried.

Motion by Horton, seconded by Loutsch, to approve the minutes of the June 27, 2017 meeting. There was no meeting on July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2017. Motion Carried.

Motion by Loutsch, seconded by Horton, to approve claims paid July 3, 2017 and payroll dated June 30, 2017. Motion Carried.
