The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in the Boardroom on March 28, 2017 at 9:30 a.m. All members were present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated. Chairman Don Kass called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Meis, to approve the March 28, 2017 agenda. Motion Carried.

Motion by Loutsch, seconded by Horton, to approve the minutes of the March 21, 2017 meeting. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Horton, to approve the payroll dated March 24, 2017. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Loutsch, to appoint Chance Klemme as Preston Township trustee to replace Terry Muth. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Meis, to declare items as surplus property for the Plymouth County Surplus Auction on May 6, 2017. List available in the Plymouth County Auditor's office. Motion Carried.

Motion by Horton, seconded by Meis, to approve the liquor license renewal for one year for Hidden Acres Golf Course. Motion Carried.

Jack Martin, landowner, was present to discuss access to his land in the SW ¼ of Section 36 of Perry Township from the old C80 that was vacated in the 1960's. The advice provided from the Board and County Attorney Darin Raymond was for Mr. Martin to pursue his own legal options for gaining access to his property with neighboring land owners.
